ABOUT THE COLORADO VOCAL ARTS ENSEMBLE

Founded in 1992 by Artistic Director Deborah Jenkins Teske, the Colorado Vocal Arts Ensemble is dedicated to bringing traditional choral works and new, innovative programming to the Colorado Springs community and beyond. While remaining primarily an a cappella chamber ensemble, CVAE collaborates with groups including the Colorado Springs Children's Chorale, the Chamber Orchestra of the Springs, The Denver Brass, Arapahoe Philharmonic, and Colorado Opera Festival. Touring has brought CVAE's music to communities throughout Colorado and New Mexico, including Sterling, Crested Butte, Albuquerque, Boulder, Alamosa and Pueblo. Through various community outreach programs, including its Voice, Verse, Vision program, a multimedia arts collaboration involving students, professional artists and composers, CVAE has shared its music with thousands of community members. High school Master Classes are CVAE's newest addition to its community outreach repertoire.

CVAE was honored to receive an invitation to perform at the 2002 Chorus America conference in Denver. CVAE's Voice, Verse, Vision received Chorus America's Education Outreach Award for 2003, a national recognition of a highly effective program at minimal cost. CVAE was also the proud recipient of the Pikes Peak Arts Council's Arts/Business/Education award for 2003, and in 2005 its Wintersong concert won their award for Best Concert by a Small Ensemble. CVAE has established a tradition of choral performance at the highest level of innovation and professionalism and plans to continue this essential contribution into the next decade.



ABOUT THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Deborah Jenkins Teske is founder and artistic director of the Colorado Vocal Arts Ensemble. She is Director of Choirs at Colorado College, where she conducts the Colorado College Choir and Chamber Chorus and teaches conducting. She has served as Associate Director of Music at Grace Episcopal Church since 1992. Although choral music is her primary focus, she has also conducted opera and musical theater, including productions of Handel's *Semele*, Britten's *The Turn of the Screw*, Puccini's *Madama Butterfly* and Mozart's *The Magic Flute* with the Colorado Opera Festival. From 1993-1998 Ms. Teske served as Chorus Master for the Festival. Other regional engagements have included Opera Theater of the Rockies, the Colorado Opera Troupe in Denver and The Fine Arts Center Repertory Theater Company. Ms. Teske holds a Bachelor's Degree in Music from Pomona College and a Master of Music in Choral Conducting from the University of Colorado at Boulder.
