The twelve member COLORADO CHAMBER PLAYERS celebrated its 15th season of innovative chamber music in 2008-09, and has been described as "Colorado's musical treasure" by the Denver Post. They have toured the USA, Brazil and Spain. Awards have included the 2005 and 2008 Adams County SCFD's Creativity Award, a 2006 Hosokawa Fellowship, a Chamber Music America Residency in 2008-09 at Children's Hospital, a "Meet the Composer" award in March 2008, an Argosy Foundation Recording grant in 2008, and a Copland Foundation (NYC) award in 2009. PAUL NAGEM has been principal flute for the Colorado Springs Symphony/Philharmonic since 1994. A native of San Diego, he studied flute there with Damian Bursill-Hall, then principal flute of the San Diego Symphony and now with the Pittsburgh Symphony. He received his Bachelor's Degree from the New England Conservatory of Music, where he studied with Lois Schaefer of the Boston Symphony. Mr. Nagem is the Instructor of Flute at Colorado College, as well as Principal Flute with the Colorado Ballet. He has performed with the San Diego Symphony, the Colorado Symphony and the Singapore Symphony. Mr. Nagem plays Straubinger flutes.

BARBARA HAMILTON-PRIMUS is the Violist and Artistic Director of the Colorado Chamber Players. She has played as Principal Viola and Soloist with the Colorado Symphony, the Orquesta Ciudad de Barcelona & the Buffalo Philharmonic, as well as tutti viola with the New York Philharmonic. She is President of the Rocky Mountain Viola Society. Her Doctorate in Viola Performance is from the Yale School of Music, where she studied with Jesse Levine and the Tokyo String Quartet. In 2005 she traveled to Beijing, China to perform at the Central Conservatory. She has performed chamber music with Daniel Gaede (Concertmaster, Vienna Philharmonic), Julia Fischer, Dmitri Sitkovetsky, David Krakauer, Roger Tapping, and Sharon Isbin. She and husband Paul Primus are the proud parents of Joshua and Lily, ages 10 and 7.

PAUL PRIMUS is Principal Second Violin with the Colorado Symphony. He has played as concertmaster with the Central City Opera Orchestra, and concertmaster with the Colorado Symphony. He received his undergraduate and graduate degrees from the University of Wisconsin, and is a member of the Lozano Quartet. He is a founding member of The Colorado Chamber Players, and is on the faculty of the Eastern Music Festival. In 1996, he toured Europe with the American Sinfonietta. Mr. Primus has recorded for the Centaur, RCA Victor and Raccoon Hollar labels. In summers 2006-07, he taught at the Rocky Ridge Music Center and performed at the Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival with members of the Colorado Symphony and Maestro Jeffrey Kahane. Summer 2009 will find Paul teaching at the Lamont School of Music Pre-College Academy.

Canadian cellist, **JUDITH McINTYRE**, attended the University of Toronto and Manhattan School of Music obtaining Bachelor's and Master's Degrees of Music. In May 2003, she won a position with the Colorado Symphony orchestra in the position of Third Chair Cello. Afterwards the former music director of the CSO, Marin Alsop, invited her to play in her preeminent contemporary music festival, the Cabrillo Festival in Santa Cruz, California. As member and principal cello of the Verbier Festival Orchestra in Switzerland, she has had the opportunity to play in some of the world's greatest concert halls, at the World Economic Forum in Davos in January of 2003 and most recently on tour with Joshua Bell in October 2008. Ever active as chamber musician, she is in constant demand in her current hometown of Denver, Colorado, performing with the Front Range Chamber Players, the Colorado Chamber Players, and is a founding member of the Zephyr Ensemble.
